Swift Bay Low Beach; 38 mew gulls, 9 glaucous-winged gulls, 6 American crows, 9 surf scoters, 6 buffleheads.

5:20 A.M. 207 cormorants including pelagic and double-crested, left roosting cliffs at NW corner Humphrey Head when a bald eagle flew by just overhead.

5 bald eagle sightings today.

April 7, 1990

madrona with yellow inflorescence on W side Blakely Island and has been for last week.

at Lopez ferry terminal at 9:20 A.M. 2 ad. bald eagles flew ^{E 2 1/10 mi.} out to a fishing group of 121 pelagic cormorant, 60 double-crested cormorant, 8 rhinoceros auklet, 29 glaucous-winged gulls. The eagle did not contact water but partially displaced the other birds. The eagles then flew back to perching tree on N end Upright Head and in 5 minutes flew back to the fishing group of birds. While watching the aquatic birds 3 separate boats changed their course to head directly into the fishing group. Near ferry terminal were 6 western grebes.

 Left Lopez ferry terminal at 10:18 A.M. via Anacortes, waterfalls active at Thatcher on Blakely Island. 10:30 A.M. Willow Island. 10:33 SW Blakely Island at light beacon. 10:36 A.M. Usual glaucous-wing gulls on Pointer Island. On S end 80 cormorants. 10:39 3 double-crested cormorants, 10:43 A.M. 3 glaucous-winged gulls, 1 pigeon guillemot. 10:46 A.M. double-crested cormorant. 10:58 arrive Anacortes. 3 pigeon guillemots, 1 red-necked grebe at terminal. Left Anacortes ferry terminal at 11:43 A.M. 12:30 Rhododendron Restaurant at Bow City. No 71 to Chuckanut Drive to Bellingham arriving Blaine on Interstate 5 at mileage 206 ^{P.M.} (from Anacortes). Thence into Canada, 99 to Vancouver Airport. 82 miles from Anacortes arriving at 2:45 P.M. on 3 hours traveling time. With Mary & Son and Annette we continued to Vancouver for the night, after
