

having visited Granville Island. Lodging in Vancouver proper (Holiday Inn)

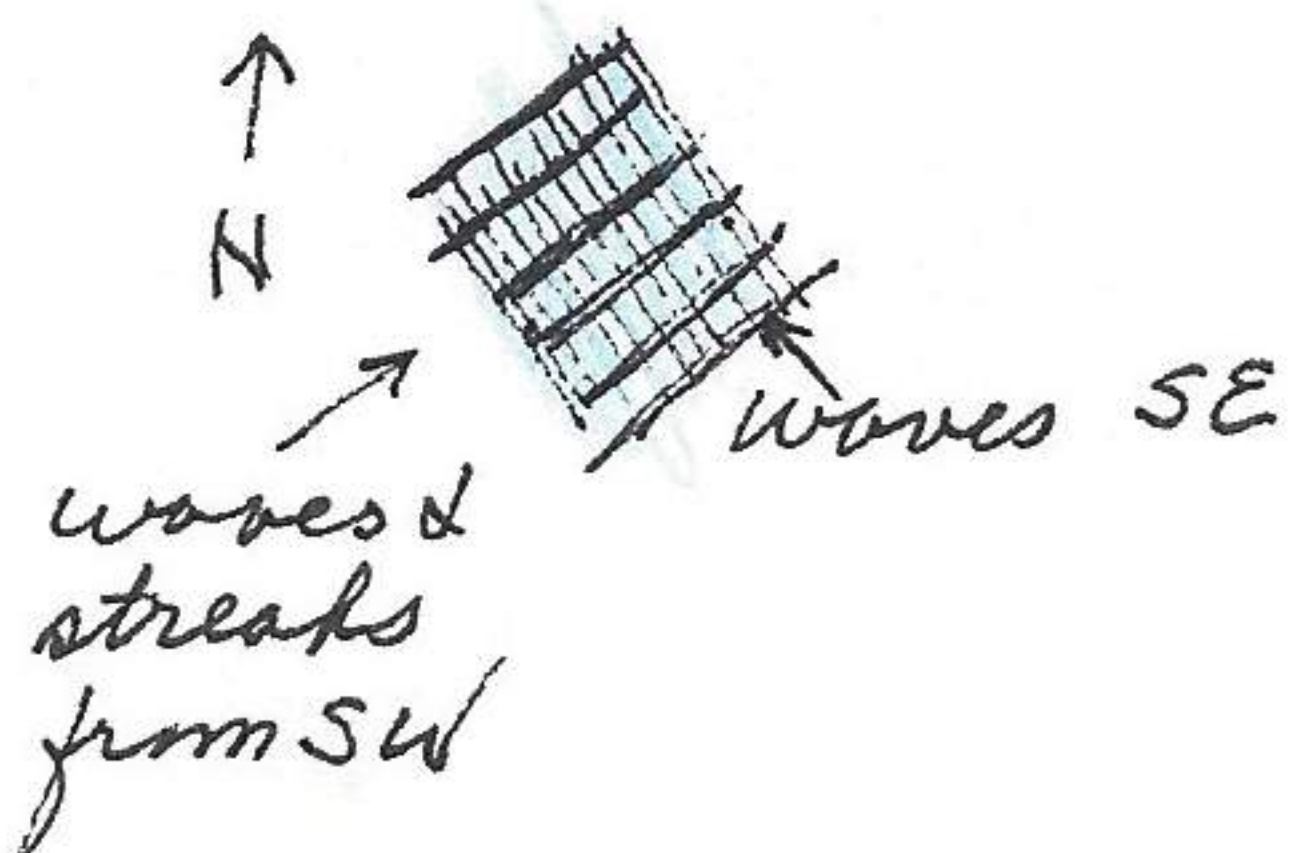
April 8, 1990

Vancouver, Canada. This A.M. checked Stanley Park, near restaurant there noted melanistic red squirrel, Tamiasciurus douglasi. In lakes noted 18 common goldeneye ducks, 1 great blue heron, 3 glaucous-winged gulls, 6 American crows. Left Vancouver and continued S to U.S., thence to Bellis Fair in n Bellingham. Arrived Anacortes ferry terminal at mileage 819.0 or 82 miles to Vancouver Airport from Lopez Island.

Bee Estate, Humphrey Head, Lopez Island, San Juan Co., Wa.
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 April 11, 1990

Piloted the Bee boat with Mary and Don to and around Frost Island and back. Between 7:30 P.M. and 7:42 P.M. winds currently from SE and waves, then wind abruptly changed and came from SW, first streaks then wavelets, both superimposed on current waves.

At same time a rainbow extended (end to end) from NE end Frost Island to beach house on NW end Bleahely Island.



April 12, 1990

1:30 P.M. river otter swam n past Bee House. 2 band-tailed pigeons at feeder.

April 13, 1990

Rain last night to at least 12:30 P.M.

Mary and Don left for Utah.

April 14, 1990

Photo 900414-1 of O'Leary's renters on shoreline. 10 of the kids had just finished of passing a ball from one group to another without being touched. Rocks and sticks were commonly thrown into the water.

Check rock quarry NW end Humphrey Head from top. 1 pileated woodpecker approx 150' due E in stump. 4 turkey vultures sailed by at top quarry. No other birds on trail to quarry and return by road to Bee House. One madonna cut at top quarry measured 18" diameter.
