

Fishermans Bay. On W side in San Juan Country observed 1 ♂ hufflehead. On E side were 4 least sandpipers, 3 american crows. No other birds.

at Swift Lagoon: 1 cinnamon teal, 6 green-winged teal, 5 mallards, 8 northern pintails, 6 godwits, approx. 110 least sandpipers, 3 barn swallows, 7 violet-green swallows.

10:20 A.M. 2 adult bald eagles feeding on dead harbor seal on Flat Point, N of Spring Cove.

Each bald eagle would feed 5-6 minutes then move out 8-10 feet

while other eagle fed for about same period of time. She left after 15 minutes, flew toward Leo Reef, circled and one flew N and the other returned to harbor seal. 1 common raven fed within 1 foot of eagles but always respected eagles.

4:10 P.M. 2 turkey vultures and one raven arrived at seal and all fed on the seal, raven dominated.

9:00 P.M. river otter swam N past Bee House
