


A ♀ ^{29" high at shoulders} at Bee House had noticeable abdominal twitches: recorded seconds between these twitches or contraction:

noted. ♀ mule deer with blood stained hair on posterior (recent parturition.).



May 30, 1990

♂ of last year (fawn) 1" high antlers. This is first time for antler development

2 ♂ 26 1/2 inches high at shoulders with antlers just budding.

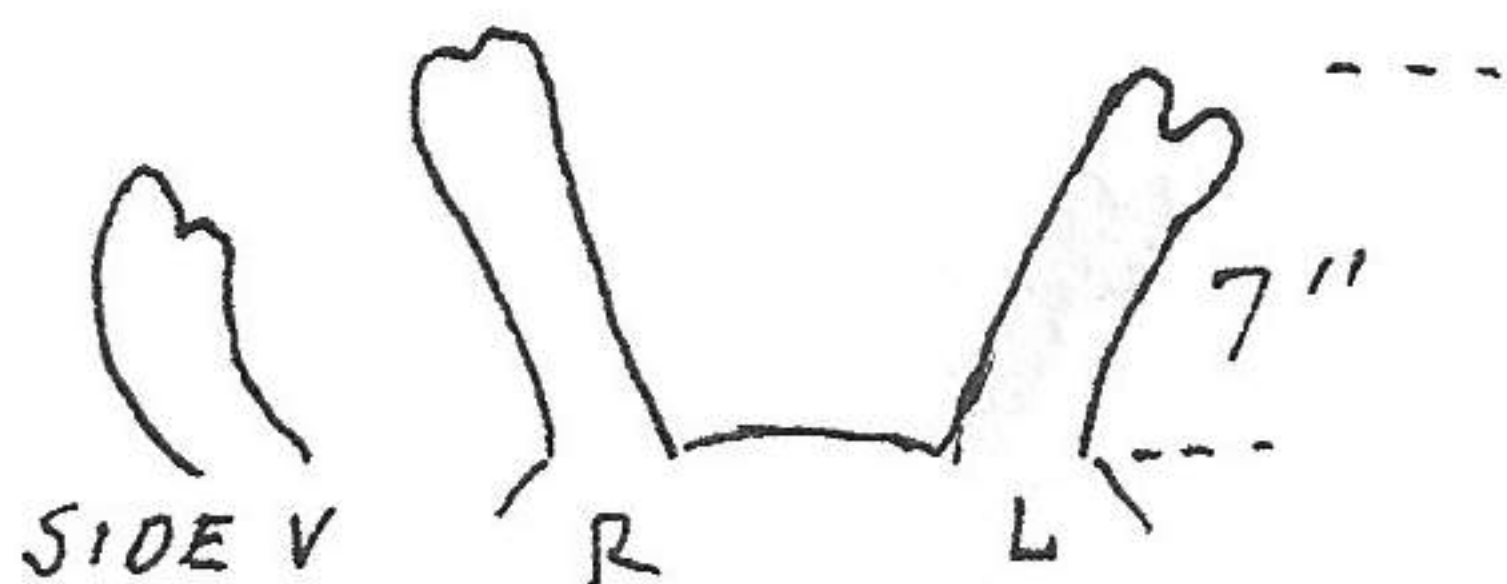
Left Lopez Island this A.M for Anacortes. 16 harbor seal Leo Reef on n side, 1 double-crested cormorant and 2 glaucous-winged gulls. SW end Blakely. Usual glaucous-winged gulls on Painter Island. Arrived Anacortes. Left Anacortes 5:20 P.M pelagic cormorant, 4 rhinoceros auklet in Rosario Straits, one glaucous-winged gull W end Thatcher Pass, Arrived Lopez Islands. Birds rare between Lopez Island and Anacortes.
