

June 10, 1990

Left Anacortes 9:00 A.M. by ferry for Lopez Island, raining at E side Rosario Strait 8 rhinoceros auklet in one group and 7 in another group. These were only birds observed on trip. Arrived Lopez Island 9:35 A.M. 58 glaucous-winged gulls on ferry pilings at Lopez Island terminal

From Bee House can see 21 harbor seal on Leo Reef and bald eagle on nest on NE corner Frost Island.

Lopez Island, Humphrey Head, San Juan Co., Washington

June 11, 1990 (see June 3 for itinerary)

Departed Shoal Bay on Lopez Island at 5:14 P.M. for trip to S.E. Alaska via the 'Bee' (32 Grand Banks) ^{mileage meter 2718.0}. Passing Lopez Island ferry terminal counted 73 glaucous-winged gulls on piling of terminal. Continued past Hankin Point, Point Hudson, Bell Island, through Pole Pass, Deer Harbor to the Deer Harbor marina where we moored for the night. Only one rhinoceros auklet observed.

Deer Harbor marina, Deer Harbor, San Juan Co., Washington

June 12, 1990

Left 9:00 A.M. Route to San Juan Channel via north Pass, thence by Jones Island to San Juan Channel, at 10:07 A.M. at Sentinel Island observed first harbor seal and 1 pigeon guillemot. Traversed N side of Sentinel Island for first time. On reef to SW were 21 harbor seal. 11:00 A.M. Mandarte Island with full territorial complement of glaucous-winged gulls. 2 double-crested cormorant and approx. 200 glaucous-winged gulls in compact group resting on NW end of island. Only 4 glaucous-winged gulls in air beyond the island and none on reef (beacon). On approach to Sidney Spit (E side of spit) observed 2 and 3 pelagic cormorants, 3 rhinoceros auklets, 1 rhinoceros auklet, 1 pelagic cormorant. Along shoreline on E side were 57 glaucous-winged gulls, 5 pigeon guillemots, 4 rhinoceros auklets and approx 15 other birds that were not identifiable. Arrived NW end Spencer Spit 11:45 A.M.
