


900720-33 12:39 P.M. Rugged mt. country in vicinity of Glikey Glacier.

900720-36. Juneau airport with Mr. Russell Shorb the pilot and manager of Wing Airlines. We arrived at airport on our return trip (setdown) at 12:56 just exactly 1 1/2 hrs of flight. We circled W and S and made our approach from SE. The topo maps (USGS) show airport with extension attached to bottom of page A. It belongs at bottom thus: . The best position for photography is in back 2 seats so that one can shift from left to right and right to left as occasion demands. The strut is also out of the way. The windows were plastic and not optically favorable. They should be optically perfect.

Left 10:40 A.M. by Bee Boat. Plan to go south in Gasteneau Channel and then out around Douglas Island into Stephens Passage because of the shallow and narrow passage at n end of Douglas Island. It requires at least a 16' tide to safely negotiated the passage in a boat the size of ours. 10:57 AM salmon jumped. 10:57 AM, 2 marbled murrelet. 11:10 AM - pigeon guillemot. 11:20 AM. Salmon jumped 1 1/2 feet. 11:22 AM and 11:25 AM salmon jumped out of water. 11:29 pigeon guillemot. 11:39 2 mew gulls. 11:43 2 salmon each jumped completely out of water 2 times, one straight up and the other a forward leap. 11:48 AM. salmon jumped 1 1/2', 8 mew gulls. 12:01 P.M. 109 mew gulls in one compact group and feeding. 12:06 P.M. Marmion Island, now W., 1 hr, 25 min. from Juneau. 12:14 P.M. 3 mew gulls and 12 glaucous-winged gulls on log. 12:17 P.M. 2 marbled murrelet. 12:24 mew gull, 12:45 P.M. mew gull, 1:20 P.M. Point Hilda, 12:1 P.M. glaucous-winged gull. 1:26 P.M. 2 mew gulls. Adult bald eagle flew out over water and returned. 158 northern sea lion with fish approx. 15" long, 42 mew gulls associated. 2:02 Middle Point, 18 mew gulls on sand bar. 2:32 outer Point. 2:54 Portland Island. 3:56 S end Aaron Island. 4:06 P.M. 2 marbled murrelet. 4:20 P.M. Common loon.
