

Recorded information from James Robert Bee's trip at this point from Garden City June 20, 1990 to Ketchikan July 1 and from Skagway Aug. 3, 1990 to Lopez Island Aug 20, 1990. This information is not in chronological order and was taken (in part) from Log Book of the "Bee". Only natural history info selected. Dolphins Rodson Point, outside Port Hardy. Bald eagles Seymour Narrows and Port Hardy. Orcas, 10 of them past Edinbrook Island (June 25), 2 bald eagles resting in trees in Lama Passage. Dall porpoise, Johnston Straits (June 23.) The Edinbrook observation was several bulls swimming separately from smaller Orcas. Left Shearwater 5:00 A.M. 2 bald eagles just outside harbor (June 26). 4 Dall porpoise after crossing sound, then 3 guided boat before Cone Island. Frozer Passage 6-7 bald eagles midway in Malcolm Passage, 4 Dall porpoise. Bristol Bay overnight, 2 ^{see} otter, 2 bald eagles, caught 2 Chinook salmon. June 27, left Bishop, 4 Orcas blowing 1/2 way thru Grenville Channel, several dolphins. Prince Rupert June 27, at Kumealon Inlet. June 30, left Prince Rupert at 10:30 A.M. Ketchikan June 30. James R. Bee and party flew out of Ketchikan to Lawrence, Kansas.

On return trip James Robert Bee, Dick Dunkrupt, Patti Hackney (see June 20, 1990 for addresses). 196 hrs of travel from Lopez to Skagway, 191 hours from Skagway to Lopez. Left Skagway Aug 3, 1990 for Lopez Island, Wa. no wildlife observations listed on return trip.
