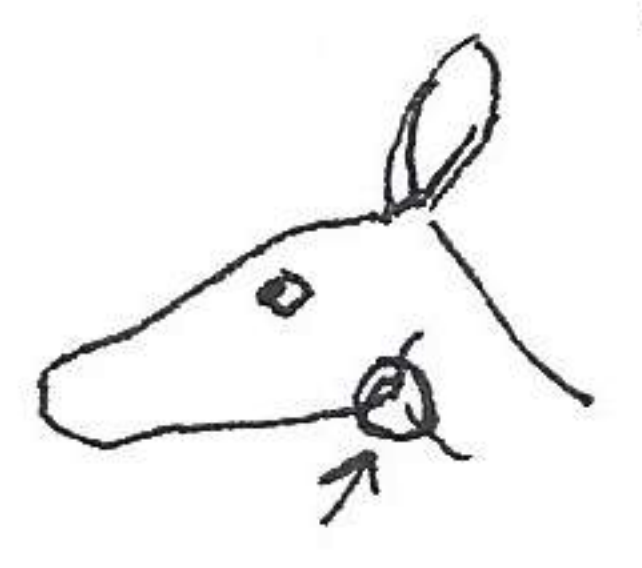


another spotted fawn has an abscess on medial jaw-throat area.

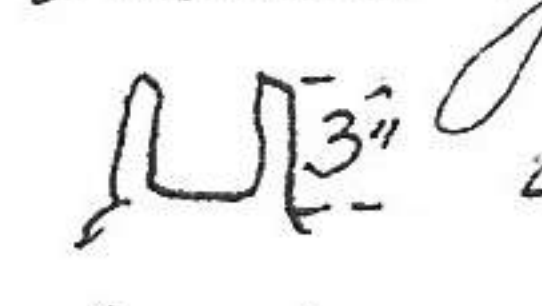
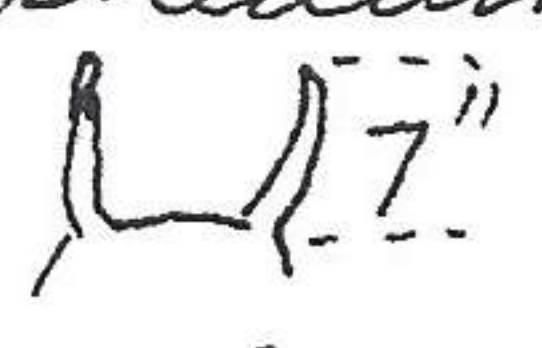


An adult female chased a 3" spike at full speed for 100 or so feet. Townsend chipmunk active. 3 dark-eyed juncos and 1 rufous-sided towhee in area.

4 adult ♀ mule deer and 4 spotted fawns, 1 3" spike mule deer in area. One fawn with 8" injury on right side of neck. ♀ mule deer 29" high at shoulders dominant. One adult ♀ with 30" high fawn 22" high at shoulders. Fawns when hand fed move in and out with hesitation. 2 pine siskin. One northern flicker feeding on ground. This species appears about once every 10-12 days.

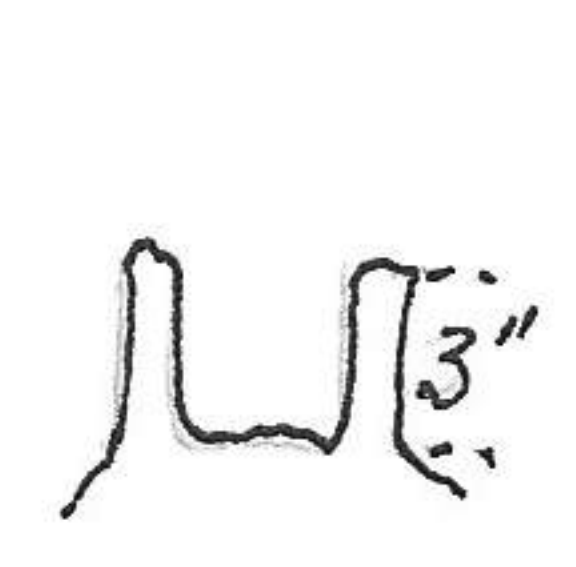
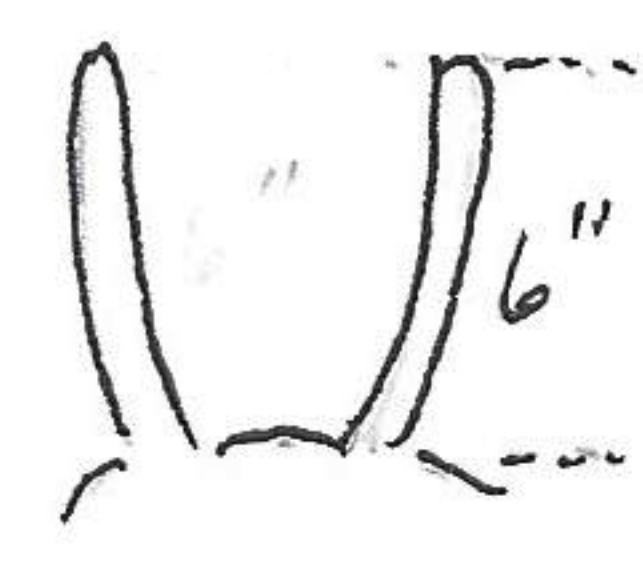

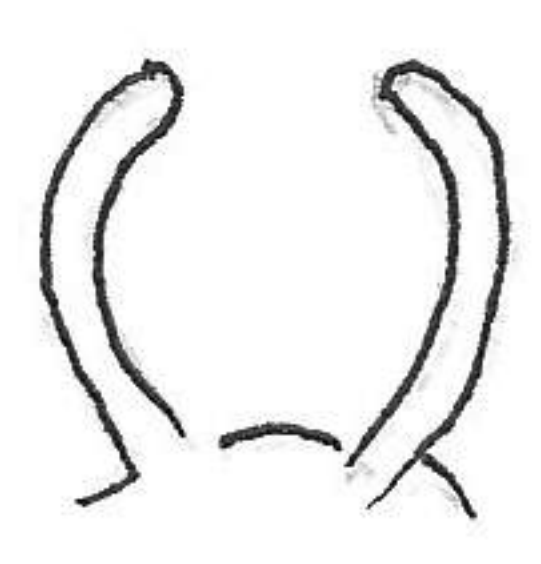
