

Bee Estate, Humphrey Head, Lopez Island, San Juan Co., Washington.

Aug. 9, 1990

Left Lopez Island 9:42 A.M. for Anacortes. Harbor seal 150' from terminal. 2 glaucous-winged gulls. 9:50 A.M. mew gull. 9:52 AM 3 mew gulls. Shorelines and slopes of islands are light brown of dry grasses. 9:54 A.M. S end Willow Island, glaucous-winged gull. 9:57 A.M. W end Thatcher Pass at red light beacon. 2 Bonaparte gulls. 10:00 A.M. 62 Bonaparte gulls on bull kelp at Lawson Rock. No gulls on Pointon Island, dry grass on top. 10:01 4 mew gulls, 10:02 AM 1 Bonaparte gull. 10:26 mew gull. 10:09 now SW Cypress Island, (beacon). 10:10 A.M. marbled murrelet, 10:22 AM arrive Anacortes, 65 gulls on piling in SW bay, including glaucous-winged, mew and Bonaparte. One glaucous-winged gull on piling (nesting) 3/4 size adult.

To mt. Vernon, La Conner thence river road to Lybourn, at 3/10 mi ⁿ junction Pine Island Road and road turning n. observed approx. 2,500 mew gulls generally distributed in field. Red-tailed hawk 2 mi. S Stanwood. Continued to Chris' on Lost Lake Rd.

Aug 12, 1990

Left Chris' and returned to Anacortes ferry terminal. Enroute on highway 9 and Stevens Lake opossum road kill, Left on ferry 5:27 P.M. 5:39 mew gull, 5:40 mew, 5:43 glaucous-winged gull. 5:44 Lawson Rock. 5:49 mew gull. 5:50 S end Willow Island. 5:53 glaucous-winged gull. Arrived Lopez Island, approx 6:06 P.M.

Aug. 14, 1990

Swift's Bay. 42 western sandpipers, 2 killdeer.

Aug. 15, 1990

Left Lopez Island on ferry for Anacortes. Survey starboard for census out 200'. Left 6:53 A.M. 6:56 2 mew gulls. 6:59 marbled murrelet. 6:59 n. side Leo Reef. Rocks 2-6 3 harbor seal. also 1 glaucous-winged gull rocks 1-6, 2 on rock no 9, and 2 on rock no. 10. 15 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island, 2 immature unable to fly. On n Flower Rock, 13 harbor seal, Little Flower Rock 2 harbor seal 7:05 A.M. S end Willow Island, 2 marbled murrelet. 7:07 A.M. red light beacon SW end Blakely Island. 7:08 adult bald eagle in tree on decatur. 7:10 A.M. Lawson Rock. 7:11 Fauntleroy Point. 7:13 A.M. 2 glaucous-winged gulls. 7:18 mew gull. 7:19 common
