 fawns fading.


4:00-4:30 P.M. Distinct purple ^{red} zone following current lines

 Flower Island and on territories 7:09 SW Blasely Island, 2
 pigeon guillemots. 7:13 Point Fauntleroy. Fog in Rosario
 Straits, wind calm, no currents, 100' visibility. 7:19 2 glaucous-
 wing gully flying in fog. Arrive Anacortes.
