

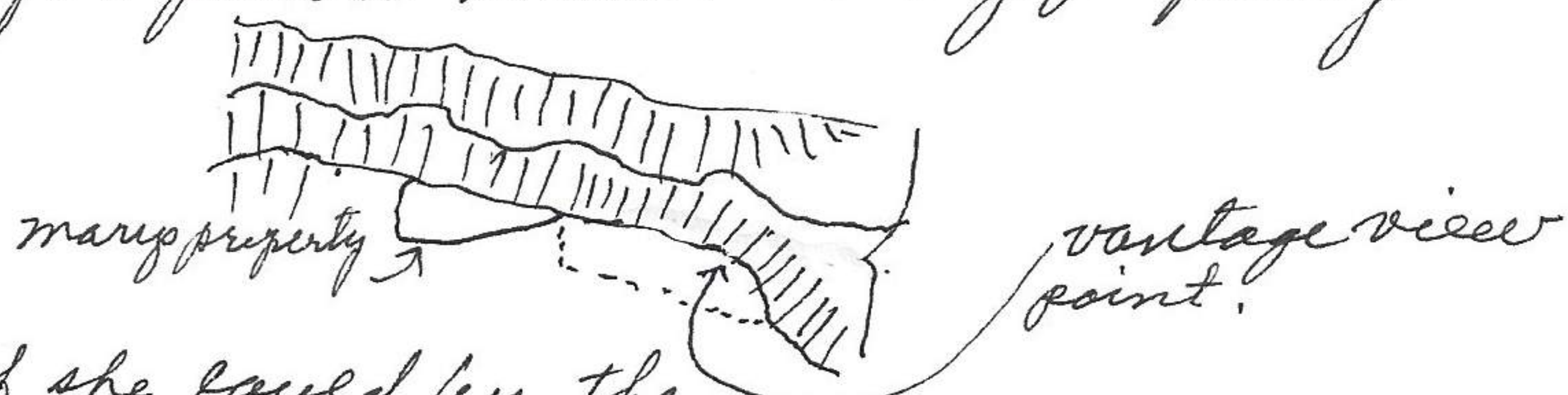

Fairbanks, Alaska

Sept 5, 1990

Steller's jay along Tanana River. 6:34 P.M. Nenana bridge, Common raven. 6:49 red squirrel. 7:04 P.M. sparrow hawk. Arrived Healy and visited Mary P. Bee property in the private wedge in Mc. Kinley National Park. This area is being developed for private homes. Mary's property marker SE? is

Arrived McKinley National Park. 3 hrs later from Fairbanks.

Sept. 6, 1990

Fernweed inflorescence replaced by whitish achenes, some basal leaves bright red.

Headquarters Mc. Kinley Nat'l Park. met Kennan Ward and his wife and 2 other parties of Mary's. Canada jay at headquarters. 10:40 A.M. 10 Barren ground Caribou, one in velvet, one red antlers and the rest in clear antlers of autumn. Then approached down ridge, ran across drainage near road and then on hillside again continued grazing and moving forward, all males, near mountain to right with curved profile. 11:02 Sanctuary Liver, Canada jay. Telanika River, 11:36 A.M. Canada jay. Eagle Cr. Bridge, 2 Dall sheep. 12:09 P.M. Grizzly bear at creek. It progressively fed on blueberries as it moved along a horizontal level. 12:10 P.M. 2 grizzly bears moving up ridge to W. 12:17 Dall sheep trail well formed up ridge and following straight up slope. Trail bare
