1:35 P.M. a harbor seal fed from 5' to 25' out from shore below Bee House. It floated on back with head to eye level above water and upper part of body (ventral). The whiskers and jaw and nostrils were above water. In this position the seal can see below and in front and when a fish is spotted, the seal dives ventrally up then changes position in a 1/2 turn for the chase. The on surface stance is generally 6-12 seconds. This seal has been observed on other occasion as told by the character of its spotting. I would judge it to be 50" in length.

A belted Kingfisher perched on deadhead, out from Spring Cove, for 15 minutes.

A northern flicker flew N past Bee House at approx 40' high and out along the shoreline.


