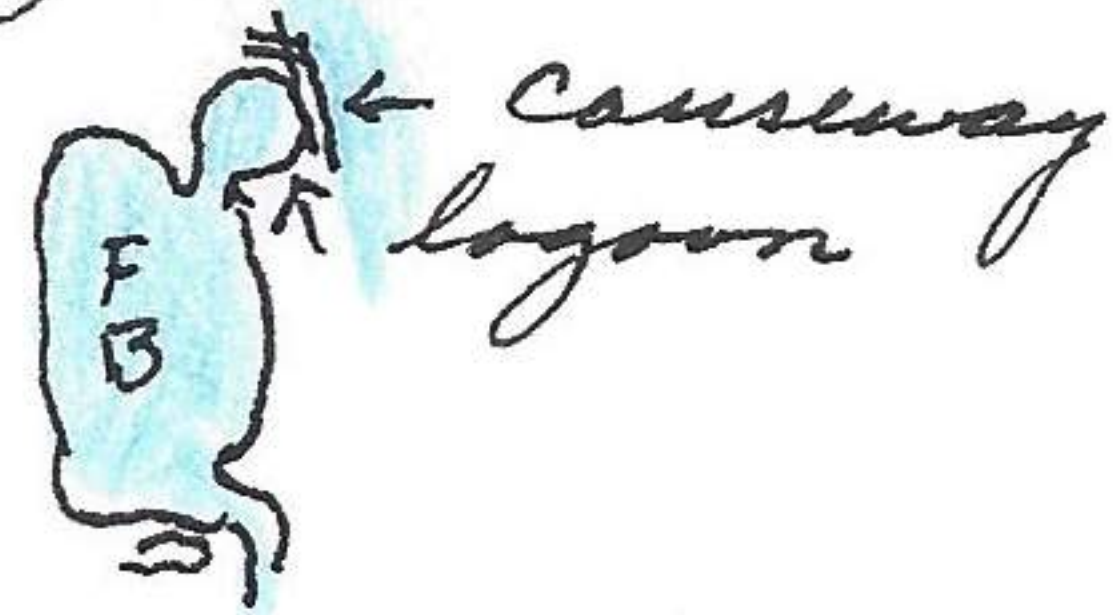


in winter pelage.

On west side causeway of Fisherman Bay Lagoon (will use this name for lagoon at SW end Fisherman Bay with causeway on W side). On west side of causeway in Sanguan channel observed: 5♂ 5♀ Harlequin ducks in one close group, 1 common loon. On east side causeway: 6 glaucous-winged gulls and 1 great blue heron.



In Swifts Lagoon: 21 mallards, 9♀ 2♂ northern pintails, 11 green-winged teal.

At Bee House 2nd year ♂ with antler buds 

Oct. 10, 1990

To Chris' at Lost Lake, thence Uni. Wa. med. center for eye angiogram. Orbow Lake at junction Elliott and Fales rds: 26 Canada geese, 43 mallards, 6 pintail, 4 green-winged teal.

On return from med. center observed approx. 2,000 Bonaparte gulls in sanitation settling basins NE Everett. The Bonaparte gulls have a general distribution in fields and on bodies of inland waters. At junction Best Road and highway 20 in Skagit Valley, redtail.

At Anacortes ferry terminal at 6:30 a.m. 3 flocks of mallards 9, 18, 11 flew E at approx 300' high. Left ferry terminal 6:47 p.m. for Lopez Island. Sun already set. No census.

Oct 11, 1990

Fished from the Bee boat in Shoal Bay (S end at moorage) and caught 3 sand sharks (spiny dogfish, Squalus acanthias, measuring 18♀, 24♂, 26♂.

Oct. 12, 1990

3 river otter swam S past Bee House. First observed since last recorded in journal.

Oct 13, 1990

8:50 A.M. 2 cooper's hawks at Bee House. They hunted singly or in unison at feeder and out as far as 50' on either side. The first approach was high speed 3' above feeder. At one time 2 American crows chased the hawks, then the hawks reversed the act and chased the crows. The crows evaded by irregular flight out over the water.

8:55 A.M. river otter swam S past Bee House and beyond Lichen Point. Travelled approx. 10' from shore except bypassed Spring Cove.
