The numbers of mule deer at feeder (2) are the fewest we have observed.

The madrona to right was in full berry production last year and not this year. Several other trees on ^{Bee} Estate have this cyclic pattern of inflorescence.

9:50 A.M. approx 4000 Bonaparte gulls 95% in flight between E of Bee House to Thatcher Pass in N. Lopez Sound. Some areas looked like a ^{snow} storm. 10:00 A.M. all Bonaparte gulls have left area except approx. 30 which remain in the area most of the time. 6-8 habitually use area between Boundary Point and Lichen Point and mainly 5'-30' from shore.

Deciduous trees on NW Blakely mostly yellowish, the big-leaved maple the brightest yellow.
