

Nov. 12, 1990

6:30 AM. Observed sequence morning color over Blakely Island from Bee House. Clouds beginning to redden, especially clear area of horizon.

7:00 AM red replaced with yellow, first on horizon.

7:10 AM losing yellow. 3 min. before yellow left clouds faintly red.

7:15 A.M. red tint and yellow gone. 3 photos with Annettes camera.

Chipmunks, (Townsend) active.

12:05 adult bald eagle circled 3 times above Bee House.

10:00 AM

Nov. 13, 1990

Water from Spring Cove 2 qts per second. Townsend chipmunks active.

Nov. 14, 1990

From causeway at S. Fishermans Bay Lagoon observed (on W side in sound): 6 Harlequin ducks, 3 glaucous-winged gulls, 14 buffleheads. On E side Causeway in lagoon, 23 bufflehead along S shore, 11 white-winged scoters, 16 greater scaup, 1 river otter on grassy shoreline, it left and fished N into Fisherman Bay. 8 bufflehead in most northern part of lagoon, 2 great blue heron and 1 common loon.

At Swift Bay: 5 mallards, 6 gadwall.

at Humphrey Lagoon: 3♀, 3♂ bufflehead, 4 glaucous-winged gulls.

At Bee House to S. 18 double-crested cormorants, 2 marbled murrelet, 2 Bonaparte gulls, 1 mew gull, 3 glaucous-winged gulls.

Nov. 15, 1990

Townsend chipmunks active. 2 bald eagle sightings today. ♀ mule deer at feeder 30 1/2" high at shoulders; one of her young, a ♀ 26" high at shoulder; another ♀ adult 32" high at shoulders.

1:45 P.M. Fishing group of in front Bee House. 15 Arctic loon, 18 double-crested cormorant, 2 western grebes, 3 Bonaparte gulls, 5 common mergansers.

When Arctic loon bends head forward, lighter feathers show there. All had 1 ventral throat bands and distinct contrast between black of hind neck and white throats and neck.
