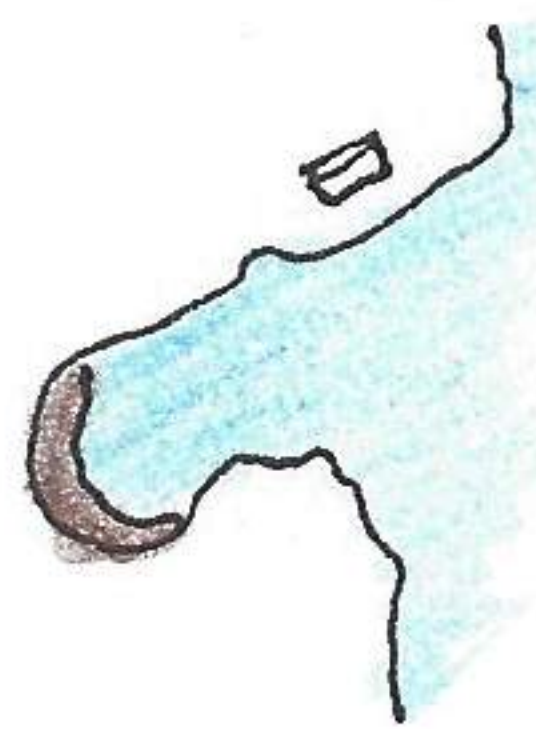


Nov. 26, 1990

9:15 AM. 5 river otter swam n past Bee House (one group),



Spring Cove restricted muddy water.

Townsend chipmunk active. 2:00 PM water from colvert under road at top Spring Cove 1.6 gal per second. noted eastern gray squirrel on benchland above Shoal Bay marina.

Nov. 27, 1990

Townsend chipmunk active.

Ferry to Anacortes. no complete census of birds. Bald eagle in tree SW end Blakely Island (on shoreline). Pelagic cormorant, common murre in groups of 1-8-6-4-7, mew gull, glaucous-winged gull, In Rosario Straits a marbled murrelet. Arrived Anacortes, thence to Chris' on Lost Lake in Snohomish Co.

At Chris' Steve had just returned from elk hunt S side Olympic mts. He observed 4 elk but no coyotes or bobcats.

Nov. 29, 1990

On return from Chris' at junction of I-5 and Conway turnoff, at a point 1/2 mi to E, observed 13 swans (sp?), They flew S the n at approx 150'. Area below flooded. One ad. bald eagle in area.

At n end Best Rd. in Skagit Valley a red-tailed hawk. Continued to Anacortes, thence Lopez Island.

Nov. 30, 1990

No Townsend chipmunks active; so between Nov 27 and 30, the chipmunks retired to hibernation

3 sightings of bald eagles this A.M. 2 flocks of surf scoters flew n past Bee House, each flock approx. 50 birds.

Last night a new slide in Spring Cove; displaced debris 8 feet below ^{head of slide} slide.

no water from original Spring Cove drainage.

1 qt per second from main source of water.
