

Continued to Cedar Flat (flat area between Hitchcock Rd and Humphrey Road.) The grand fir blown down last year has a root system, now perpendicular of $20' \times 20'$. 2 eastern gray squirrels in the flat.

Dec 4, 1990

High winds last 24 hours, estimated at 50-60 MPH. Temp 40°F at 8:00 A.M.

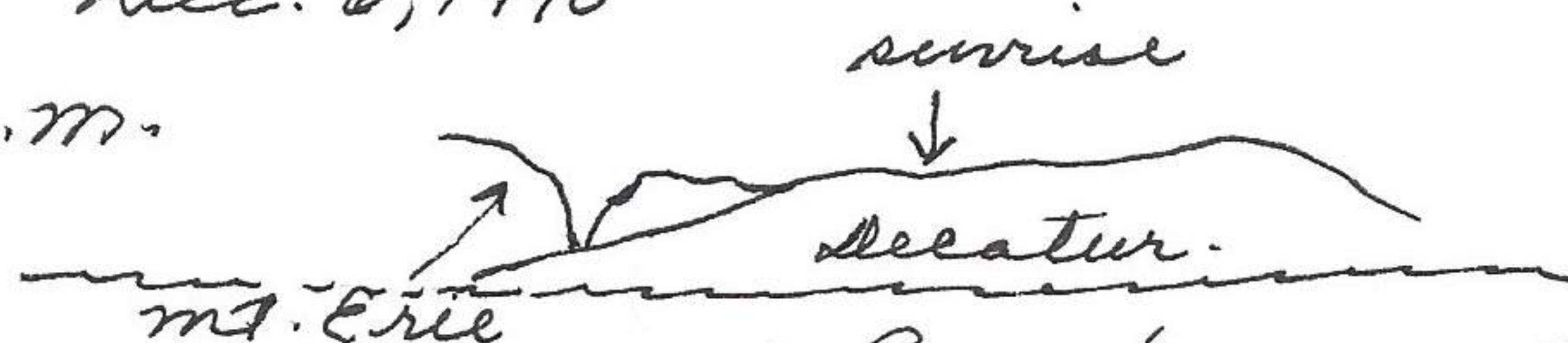
Exceptional high tide last 2 days and today is the first time all logs and debris are cleared of Spring Cove beach & bay.

at 10:00 A.M. calm, approx. 1 hr. sunshine. Since last night no electricity up to 10:30 A.M. today.

made circuit route on Humphrey Head. no birds to marina. at marina 1 red-necked grebe, 2 double-crested cormorants and 2 horned grebes. They were all feeding on small minnows in the moorage area. Cooper hawk W side half way between marina and Switchback Rd. No other birds observed.

11:55 A.M. River otter swam n past Bee House. Temp (air) 45°F at Bee House ♂ mule deer with 4 tine left side, 3 right side, including eye tine. One mule deer ♂ with 3 each tine each side including 2 eye tines.

To Chris at Lost Lake in Snohomish Co., Left Lopez Island 7:50 A.M. for Anacortes. Sky clear except high cirrus. At N end Humphrey Head 48 western grebes, 4 glaucous-winged gulls. Leo Reef. Bonaparte gull, marbled murrelet, 2 common murre, 1 mew gull. Willow Island, 2 pigeon guillemots. SW Blakely Island. beacon. 2 pelagic cormorants, 2 mew gulls, logs and debris approx average every 150', mew gull, common murre, 3 mew gulls. E Thatcher Pass. marbled murrelet. Beacon SW Cypress. 2 double-crested cormorants, 1 pelagic cormorant, common murre, 1 pelagic cormorant. Arrive Anacortes. At 1 mi E of bridge over Snohomish Canal and 800' were 2 American roughleg hawks.
