


Dec. 30, 1990


Temp this A.M. 25° F. Wind now W having changed from S. Spring Cove has 1/4 of cove in logs and debris including 15, 4x8 plywood sheets in various stages of damage. 2 of them are 10' above high tide on the slope of the cove. As tide moves out, the plywood is the last to come to rest on the exposed beach.

Ice still on shoreline. 41 American crows and 61 starling fed on madrona berries for 10 minutes then left. The starling are rarely observed at the Bee House. The American crows of 2-3 flocks of 10-40 each per day at feeder. A feeder of thistle seed has been in place all ^{spring, summer and} winter and so far no take. 2 2" spike mule deer at feeder and first ones observed for at least a month.

Dec. 31, 1990

12:00 P.M. Culvert from road drainage into Spring Cove 1/2 in ice.  Water flowing 1 qt in 35 seconds. Ice in drainage ditch long road. Snow gone from nearly all areas.

Humphrey Lagoon:  ice N end, water open in blue area

Swift Bay entirely in ice.

Hummer Lake. all ice but melting.

Fisherman's Bay and South Fisherman's Bay Lagoon all water. at Fisherman's Bay Causeway on W side only 1 black-bellied plover. On E side 28 bufflehead generally distributed, also 2 great blue heron.
