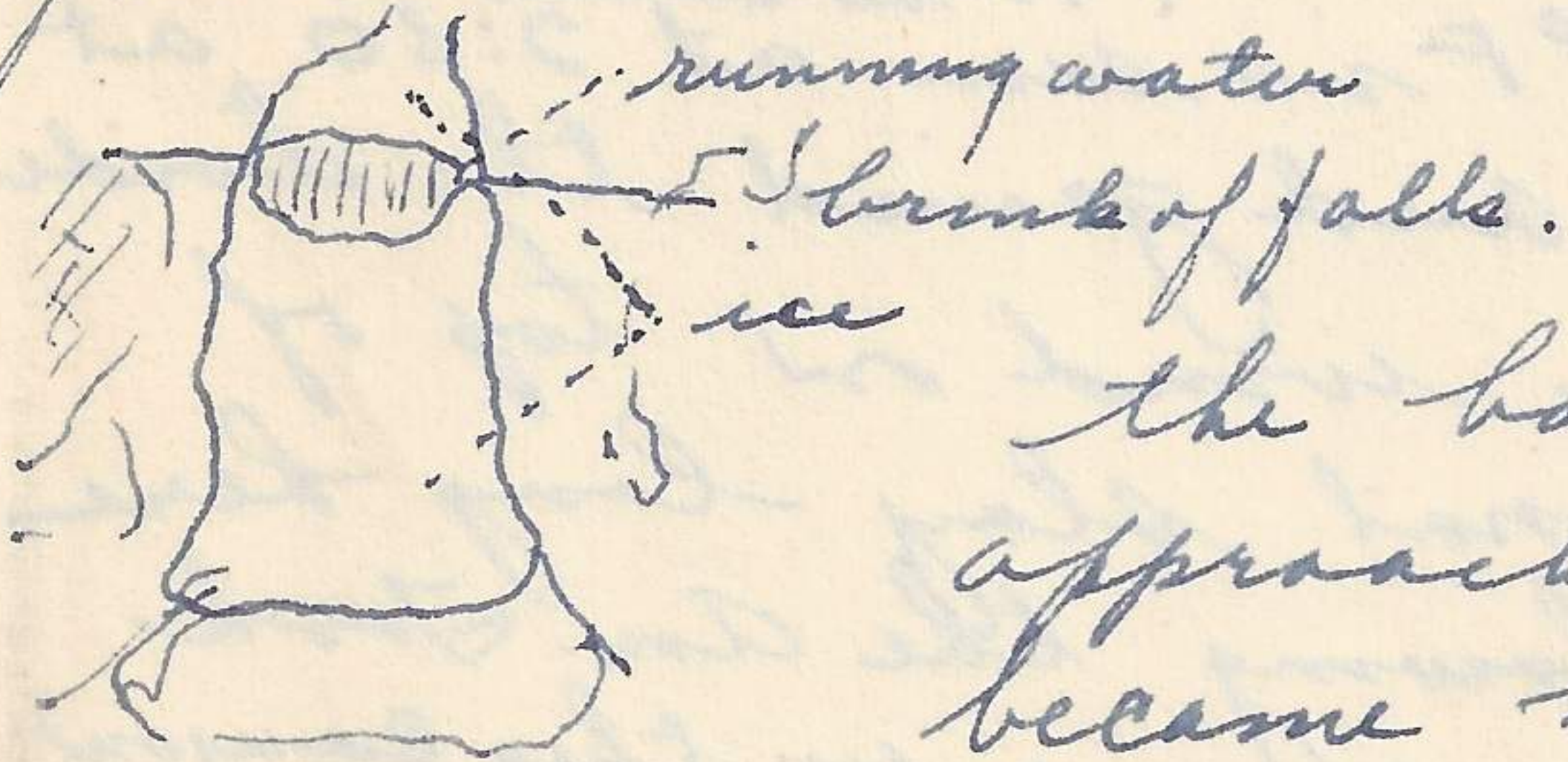


Trip to head of Grave Creek. Followed graded trail to flats, hence north to divide of Grave & Am. Fork Canyon. Returned via same way. Left Provo at about 6:10 A.M. The entire valley appeared to be enveloped in a fog with visibility about 30'. Were able to follow along highway with lights trained on yellow line. However at 12th and 5th west ran off highway into Corp Auto Court lane but turn before realizing we were off the road. Just before approaching Sinden dugway found a clear area free from fog but as soon as we descended dugway were soon enveloped again. This cleared stripe came from mouth of Provo Canyon. Arrived at mouth of Grave Canyon and with lunch and skis were soon on trail. Left mouth of Canyon proper at 6:50 A.M. Heard G.H. Owl (?) at 7:00 A.M. First switch back at 7:12. Few juncos here. Second switchback on valley border at 7:35 A.M. One buck observed here on face. 7:50 8 juncos in group. At 8:05 watched an eagle alight upon top of high cliff adjacent to the lower eagle nest. It remained stationary here for 15 minutes. Sun at 8:05 on Lake Mountain but not here yet. Porkey tracks in trail. 8:10 First spring 8:20. Few juncos, 2 deer. 8:20 The last observed eagle left cliff rest and flew north across canyon. At 8:35 had good opportunity to watch a buck on opposite side of canyon just above first Cascades. One ♀ accompanied it. It bore large baby antler and as it stately moved up hillside could see that one leg was crippled but still not enough to hinder near perfect movement. The movement of the buck is readily distinguished from the light graceful jump of the doe. At 9:00 + falls. The only part of the falls that was free of ice was the brink. The sides bottom & top of solid ice.



At 9:30 arrived at old Honor Pike camp on first flats among the conifer trees. The sun now was just getting the base of the conifer stand. As we approached the camp site the Chickadee became more in evidence, observing in the

conifer grove proper & S.T. Chickadees. They fed through aspen trees also. From here worked up main canyon to divide of Grave & Am. Fork following along the many knolls and open portions of the valley
