Since the aforesaid here arrived three Pinkes from Ireland have laden about 150 Pipes for the Leeward Islands a sloop came up from Antigua laden back with 50 Pipes a ship from ditto now in port takes in 120 Pipes to returne to said Island the Neptune Pinke Cap<sup>m</sup> Thomas Newton Comander from Barbados wil carry upwards of 200 Pipes by whom this goes recomended we had noe letter from your Brother

The 2<sup>th</sup> Curr<sup>tt</sup> arrived the Mary & Martha Cap<sup>m</sup> Anthony Madden Comander from London wil take in 200 Pipes for Jamaica we had noe letter from your good selfe

We now send you second via of our bil on St. William Shippard for . . . £ 291:01:04

= & a second via of Cap<sup>m</sup> Richard Tregians bil on ditto . . . " : 17:15:00
