the first went via Cape de verde, the second v^a Barbados, the third v^a Thenerife —

We sent you likewise our Bills via Barbados to your Brother M. W^m Heysham
for acceptance on M^r. Richard Walter £28:13:06^d & £75:13:01^d on M^r. Thomas
Ward these Bills are made payable in London —

We sent you our Bill the first via for 39130807 reis on M^r. Benjamin Niccoll
M^r. John Crose & Comp^{ys} as the Curr^{nt} of the Exchange comes from Lisbon to
London in the Month of January this went by the Poole Man of Warr via Cape de
verde — we now send you a second bill of said sum by the Pensance via Thenerife —

We sent you M. Webbs first bill for £90 — on M^r. W^m Addis of Plymouth with his
letter of advice & the like for his bill for £40 — on M^r. Thomas Layton — A
second via we sent by Barbados, & a third now goes by ditto Pensance v^a Thenerife —

any of them doe arive, altho we have Gazetts with the Common Newes from
