we have any thing more material to advise we will make addition and  
send *C*. the Man of Warr here being just now arived a ship from London  
bound to Jamaica — if any from you shall answer *C*. the same Man of Warr —

We confirme the aforegoing Duplicates & Coppins of our Addresses from the  
first of December past by severall Conveyances & now for Explanation of the  
whole you may please to note that we remitted you Capp<sup>m</sup> Tregians Bill on  
S<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Phippard £291:01:04 & S<sup>r</sup> Capp<sup>m</sup> bil on ditto S<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Phippard £17:15  
the first <sup>Bill</sup> went via Cape de verde, the second v<sup>a</sup> Barbados, the third v<sup>a</sup> Thenerife —

We sent you likewise our Bills via Barbados to your Brother M. W<sup>m</sup> Heysham  
for acceptance on M<sup>r</sup>. Richard Walter £28:13:06 & £75:13:01 on M<sup>r</sup>. Thomas  
Ward these Bills are made payable in London —

We sent you our Bill the first via for 39130807 reis on M<sup>r</sup>. Benjamin Niccoll  
M<sup>r</sup>. John Crose & Comp<sup>ys</sup> as the Curr<sup>nt</sup> of the Exchange comes from Lisbon to  
London in the Month of January this went *C*. the Poole Man of Warr via Cape de  
verde — we now send you a second bill of said sum<sup>m</sup> *C*. the Pensance via Thenerife —

We sent you M. Webbs first bill for £90 — on M<sup>r</sup>. W<sup>m</sup> Addis of Plymouth with his  
letter of advice & the like for his bill for £40 — on M<sup>r</sup>. Thomas Layton — A  
second via we sent *C*. Barbados, & a third now goes by ditto Pensance v<sup>a</sup> Thenerife —

Niccoll, M<sup>r</sup>. John Crose & Comp<sup>ys</sup> for 39130807 reis as the curr<sup>nt</sup> of the Exchange  
was from Lisbon to London in the last Month, our Conveyances are soe uncertaine  
that we are glad of every Oppertunity to address our friends, not knowing whether  
any of them doe arive, altho we have Gazetts with the Common Newes from
