Ward & Comp^{le} for £100 — with a Letter of Advice to said Gent, w^{ch} when received please to place to the Credit of our Acc^{tt}, this Ship hath lost the Oppertunity of a fair Wind being put out of the Road & the Passengers all ashore, we shall keep a Letter open for advice of any thing that may offer before the Departure —

Ditto the 28th March this Morning is come into Porte Capt^m. Fisher, the weather good, soe that wee believe his Stay will be shorte —

If there be any oppertunity, & wee can with Portugal please to send us —
