Department of Foment, duly authorized by the President of
the Republic, of one part, and John S. Casement, Contractor
of Railways, - and resident of Painesville, Ohio, of the
United States of North America, of the other part, have
agreed to celebrate the following contract.

Mr. John S. Casement, who will hereafter be called the Contractor, compromises himself to construct, for the sum of two millions, eight hundred and ninety-eight thousand, nine hundred and seventy-one dollars, and forty-three cents, American gold, and deliver in a perfect state of service, a Rāilway, that departing from this Capital, ends in the
