

BUS FULL OF BIRDS--University of Kansas vertebrate zoologist Bob Patterson positions a mounted whooping crane for a bus ride from Topeka to Lawrence, where the crane and 1,500 other mounted birds from the Goss Bird Collection will become part of the ornithological collection at the Dyche Museum of Natural History at K.U. The late Col. N.S. Goss, Neosho Falls, gave his bird collection to the state of Kansas in 1881. They were displayed in the capitol building. In 1915 the collection was moved to the State Historical Society building across the street. They were on exhibit there until K.U. acquired them this month.
