

CHITON VULGARIS

The Chiton vulgaris, which is found in the Mediterranean Sea, is a small, oval, flattened shell, with a smooth, glossy surface. It is usually found in the crevices of rocks, and is very common in the Mediterranean Sea. The shell is composed of eight plates, which are joined together by a strong, elastic ligament. The plates are arranged in two rows of four, and are separated by deep grooves. The surface of the plates is smooth, and has a slight iridescence.
