

PROCEEDINGS OF THE

1888

The first meeting of the Association was held on the 1st of January 1888 at the Hotel de Ville, Paris. The meeting was attended by a large number of delegates from various countries, and was presided over by the Hon. Mr. de la Roche.

The first business of the meeting was the election of a President and Vice-President. Mr. de la Roche was elected President, and Mr. de la Roche was elected Vice-President. The meeting then proceeded to discuss the various resolutions proposed by the delegates.

The resolutions proposed by the delegates were: 1. That the Association should be organized on a permanent basis. 2. That the Association should have a central office. 3. That the Association should have a common fund. 4. That the Association should have a common language.

The resolutions were adopted by a large majority of the delegates. The meeting then adjourned until the next meeting on the 1st of February 1888.
