

DIORITEA GIBBOSA

Diagnosis. - Body black, with a broad, white, transverse band across the middle. Head black, with a white spot on the vertex. Wings black, with a white spot on the base of the forewing. Tarsus black, with a white spot on the base of the middle toe.

Length. - 1.5 mm. Head black, with a white spot on the vertex. Body black, with a broad, white, transverse band across the middle. Wings black, with a white spot on the base of the forewing.

Color. - Black, with a broad, white, transverse band across the middle. Head black, with a white spot on the vertex. Wings black, with a white spot on the base of the forewing.

Material. - One specimen, collected by the author in the island of Celebes, in the month of August, 1859.

Remarks. - This species is distinguished from the other members of the genus by the broad, white, transverse band across the middle of the body.
