

HEMITOPIDUS MELANOGASTER, WOOD.

Black-bellied Hemipoda.

Hemipodus melanogaster, Wood, Proc. Acad. Nat. Sci. Phila., 1896, p. 17.

Length 1.5 mm. Body black, with a narrow white band across the middle of the thorax. Head black, with a white band across the middle of the face. Antennae black, with a white band across the middle of the flagellum. Legs black, with a white band across the middle of the femur. Wings black, with a white band across the middle of the membrane. Tarsus black, with a white band across the middle of the segment. Claws black, with a white band across the middle of the segment.
