

PERIPHOTUS HEMATOGRAPHIC

Chromatized Emulsion

Prepared from fresh blood of the white rat, *Rattus norvegicus*, by the method of Dr. J. H. P.

The purpose of this work is to present a method for the preparation of a peripheral blood smear from the white rat, *Rattus norvegicus*, which is suitable for the study of the morphology of the red blood cells and the white blood cells. The method is based on the use of a special emulsion, which is prepared from fresh blood of the white rat, and which is used to coat the slides. The slides are then stained with a special stain, which is also prepared from fresh blood of the white rat. The slides are then examined under a microscope, and the results are recorded.

The results of this work are as follows: The peripheral blood smear from the white rat, *Rattus norvegicus*, shows a high percentage of red blood cells, which are of a normal size and shape. The white blood cells are also present in the peripheral blood smear, and they are of a normal size and shape.
