The genus Odontophorus is characterized by the following features: the body is elongated and slender, the head is small and rounded, the eyes are large and prominent, the mouthparts are well developed, and the legs are long and thin.

The species Odontophorus gonimphalus is distinguished from other members of the genus by its unique coloration and specific morphological traits. It is found in the tropical regions of the Americas, where it inhabits forest environments. The larval stages of this species are particularly noteworthy for their complex development and feeding habits.
