

# MYIAGRA CONOIDEA

Gray, *Proc.*

*Myiagra conoidea* (Gray) *Myiagra*

The species is native to the mountainous regions of the Pacific coast of North America, where it is found in the mountains of California, Oregon, and Washington. It is a small, active bird, with a slender body and a long, pointed beak. The plumage is generally brownish above and paler below, with a distinctive white patch on the throat. The bird is known for its melodious song, which is often heard in the mountains during the breeding season. It feeds on insects and small fruits, and is usually seen in small flocks.
