

CALIBRELA ZOUAMATA.

Scalp. Hairs.

General Description.

This species is found in the same localities as the preceding one, and is distinguished by the following characters.

Head and thorax brown, with a few black hairs on the vertex and sides of the head. The eyes are large and prominent. The antennae are long and slender, with the first joint very long and the second joint very short. The legs are long and slender, with the first joint very long and the second joint very short. The wings are long and slender, with the first joint very long and the second joint very short. The abdomen is long and slender, with the first joint very long and the second joint very short.

Color. Ground color brown, with a few black hairs on the vertex and sides of the head.

Measurements. Length 1.5 mm. Breadth 0.5 mm.

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
