



PSYCHORTYX PARVICRISTATUS, GILL

Small, slender, elongated, with a slightly flattened, rounded head, and a long, slender, slightly curved tail.

Length 1.5 inches.

This species is found in the same localities as the preceding one, and is distinguished by its smaller size and its more slender form.

The body is covered with a fine, granular texture, and the color is a uniform, light brown. The head is slightly flattened, and the eyes are small and dark. The tail is long and slender, and is slightly curved. The specimen is shown in a lateral view, and is resting on a light-colored surface.

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
