

SYNOPSIS OF THE SPECIES.

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- h*<sup>3</sup>. Belly red . . . . . 17. *bairdi*.
- e*<sup>2</sup>. Tail of female, like that of male, not barred.
- i*<sup>3</sup>. Top of head blue.
- n*<sup>4</sup>. Belly yellow . . . . . 18. *aurantius*.
- o*<sup>4</sup>. Belly red . . . . . 19. *surucura*.
- k*<sup>3</sup>. Top of head dark leaden grey . . . . . 20. *citreolus*.
- f*<sup>2</sup>. Tail with square white terminations to the three outer rectrices in both sexes. 21. *melanocephalus*.
- b*. Bill strong; tail-feathers beneath either wholly black or very narrowly crossed with white bars; no terminal white patch; tail less rounded, lateral feather reaching far beyond middle of tail.
- g*<sup>2</sup>. Tail with three outer feathers on each side narrowly barred with white 22. *clathratus*.
- h*<sup>2</sup>. Tail wholly black beneath in male.
- l*<sup>3</sup>. Chest with white pectoral band.
- p*<sup>4</sup>. Tail short, central rectrices with black terminal band above . . . 23. *melanurus*.
- q*<sup>4</sup>. Tail long, central rectrices wholly green above, without terminal black band . . . . . 24. *macrurus*.
- m*<sup>3</sup>. Chest without white pectoral band . . . . . 25. *massena*.
- D. Throat and chest grey; a subterminal black spot on the outer web of the two outer rectrices on each side.
- A single species (*T. roseigaster*). TMETOTROGON.
- E. Tail-feathers with prolonged terminal emarginations; wings and wing-coverts conspicuously marked with white . . . . . PRIONOTELES.
- A single species (*P. temnurus*).

SPECIES OF THE OLD WORLD.

WITH A SPACE ROUND THE EYE MORE OR LESS DENUDED OF FEATHERS.

- F. Bill moderate, maxilla serrated as in *Trogon* . . . . . HAPALODERMA.
- a*. Wing-coverts indistinctly freckled with grey and black, and washed with green; basal half only of outer rectrix black . . . . . 1. *narina*.
- b*. Wing-coverts finely freckled with grey and black; base only of outer tail-feather black . . . . . 2. *constantia*.
- G. Bill robust, with a single terminal notch . . . . . HARPACTES.
- a*. Throat black.
- a*<sup>1</sup>. Size large: wing exceeding 4 inches in length.
