



The larger colored head is very characteristic of the bird, but I cannot vouch for the details being accurate, as I am in doubt as to the arrangement of the mottled spots, they may be diagonally placed instead of horizontal as shown. The smaller colored head with the rather slightly concave crest is perfectly accurate. J. W. Wood.
