



The larger colored head is very characteristic of the bird, but I cannot vouch for the details being accurate, as I am in doubt as to the arrangement of the mallard-like spots, they may be diagonally placed instead of horizontal as shown. The smaller colored head with the rather slightly concave crest is perfectly accurate. J. W. Wood.
