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Lutopus fuscifrons

This species comes from the neighbouring islands of the Pacific Ocean, and is not recorded from the island above mentioned.

The typical specimen was taken in the autumn of 1883, at England, and has been acknowledged.

The following description is based on the specimen which has not been acknowledged.

Very similar to the typical specimen, but with a black hind neck, and a black margin on the hind wing, which are yellow in the typical specimen. Bill 0.8, tarsus 0.8.
