Dear friends:

The time has now come for a settlement of your long past due account. You surely have had plenty of time to get the money together to pay this, but my attorney suggested that I give you one more chance by writing you, reminding you of your obligation and then allowing you a few days on account of weather or other reasons, to get in to Wilson and square this account peacefully, before starting suit. October 10th is the date set so you use your own judgement and in order that it be fair to both of us you may call during business hours at the Wilson State Bank who will turn over your order when settled. I am often out on calls and other business and might not be in when you come.

In case you have forgotten about the deal, Mr. Fred Zvolanek asked about wedding pictures and prices when getting some Kodak pictures. Later he and Miss Blanche Pracher came in and looked them over and asked me to be ready on July 20th 1938 to take three large groups and two small ones. (I took five large groups and four small ones at the same price) On this date I made these sittings without the usual deposit of one third down before sittings are made, because my experience with both families had been that they were trustworthy and prompt pay when work was delivered. Later on in August Mr. & Mrs. Fred Zvolanek returned with the proofs and ordered me to make (36) of the (4x6) photos from three different poses and (6) of the (8x10) groups, they picking out folders which I used as far as they would go, substituting a higher priced one for (8) of the small photos. Miss Marie Pracher came for the finished job and took them with the promise to bring in the money Monday (two days later). About two weeks later on Oct. 2nd 1938 Mrs. F.J. Pracher brought all pictures back stating that they were no good or something to that effect. The Eastman Kodak Company demonstrator from K.C. was here soon after and pronounced them A-1 in any studio. In January 1939 I started to Ellsworth to turn it over to an attorney and out of respect to Mr. & Mrs. Zvolanek's who hadn't seen the pictures, I stopped there. They liked them they said and told me they would have Fred stop in soon, so I feel now that I have been patient enough in waiting this long. Mr. Zvolanek called later to ask the results.

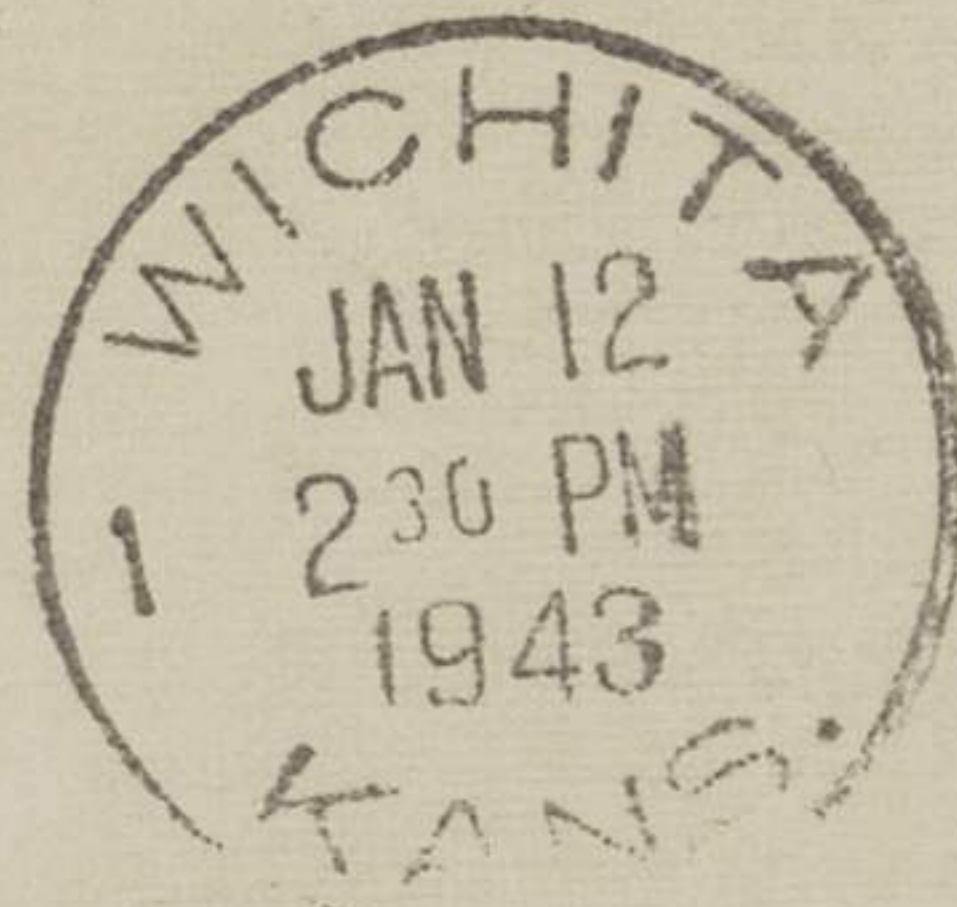
