

Boston Oct. 10, '56.

Dear Madam.

At a meeting of the Executive Committee of the N. E. Sm. And Co. held on the 3d. inst. a letter was read from your husband resigning his situation as Agent of the Company.

Whereupon the following resolutions were passed; viz.

"Voted that the resignation of Dr. Charles Robinson, as Agent of the Co., in accordance with his wish as expressed in his letter of September 15th. 1856, be hereby accepted, to take effect Oct. 3d. inst.

Voted that in consideration of the valuable services rendered by Dr. Robinson, from the date of the first organization of this Co. to the present time, his salary be continued for six months from this date, at the rate of one thousand dollars per annum.

Voted that Dr. Robinson be requested to continue his correspondence with the Executive Committee as heretofore, and to communicate with them at such times as he may deem expedient in re-
