Gentlemen

Enclosed with this are two notes of five thousand dollars each, of the Lawrence University of Wisconsin, which with the interest added amount to eleven thousand, six hundred & ninety six $\frac{14}{100}$ dollars, as of today. Also a certificate of stock in the New England Emigrant Aid Co^y (pay \$2000) worth one thousand dollars or more at the present time. In all \$12696.14, which has been transferred to yourselves, to be held by you in trust, & the income to be used for the advancement of the religious and intellectual education of the young in Kansas Ter^y. Until I shall give directions to the contrary, I wish one half of the income to be applied to the establishment of the best system of common schools, by organizing in every settlement those who shall be in favor of its adoption as soon as the school funds shall be rec^d from the U.S. Gov^t; also by giving aid to a school in Lawrence which shall serve as a model for others.

The other half of the income to be used for the establishment of Sunday schools & furnish^g them with the books of the Sunday School Union of Phil^a.

In the event of my decease without giving any other directions than the above, I wish the fund to be
