

To the Register and Receiver in and for the Territory of Kansas

Gentlemen

The undersigned, Charles Robinson, of the town of Lawrence in said Territory respectfully begs leave to submit for your consideration the following statement, the truth of all of which said statement he the said Robinson is able and ready to establish by legal testimony. That is to say: -

That he the said Robinson did in the month of ^{July} ~~in the~~ of the year A. D. 1854 settle upon and commence improving the Quarter of Section in Township and Range in the County of in ~~the~~ Territory of Kansas for the purpose and with the intention of pre-empting the same; and that the said Quarter section of land was then vacant and unoccupied by any other person at the time of said settlement by him, the said Robinson, and that he is the original occupant thereof, and has never abandoned or relinquished his claim and right thereto or settlement thereon.
