



but continues to claim the same as herein
after stated.

That in the month of _____ in the
year A.D. 1855; contrary to my wishes and against
my consent, and without any abandonment,
relinquishment or quit claim by him the
said Robinson of ~~the~~ to the said quarter section
of land as aforesaid, one William H. R. Lykins
attempted to locate a Wyandott Reservation of
six hundred and forty acres on a section of land
embracing the ~~Quarter~~ section aforesaid, or a
part thereof; and that the said Lykins gave
public notice that he had located the said
Reservation on the section of land aforesaid.

And further that the said Robinson
having been in continuous possession as
the original claimant of said ~~Quarter~~
section of land did on the 15th day of
October A.D. 1855 locate a "Wyandott Reservation"
of six hundred and forty acres of land on
the said ~~Quarter~~ section or a part thereof and
upon other adjoining land unclaimed
by any other person. That the said
Reservation had been previously bought
by one Samuel C. Pomeroy of one William
M. Tenney a Wyandott Indian, to whom
the said Reservation had been granted
