

of the matter, provided that a writ of error in the supreme Court of the Territory shall be heard by the supreme court created by the act of Congress of the first of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and the district courts created by the act of Congress of the first of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, shall have and exercise the same powers and jurisdiction under the Constitution and laws of the United States as shall be vested in the circuit courts of the United States, and the said supreme court and the respective district courts shall have the right to issue habeas corpus in all cases where it may be necessary, and the judges of the United States Supreme Court, the first six days of each month, shall be present in the Territory, and as shall be necessary for the trial of cases arising under the Constitution and laws of the United States, and appeal in all cases from the district courts of said Territory, and the judges of the said supreme court shall receive in full for their services.
