Tues 11 Pleasant - Ironed several pieces - Made potatoe soup with 60 peas in it & dumplings. Picked 2 qts currants. Called to Simmons to see what the time might be - 1/2 past 3 - Stayed 1/2 an hour. Read (sang) &

Weds 12 Looks as if it would rain - Vesta is making a foolish parade (I think) and I fear I shall dislike her. Ironed a few more pieces. Cooked another soup, put dried beef & an onion & a little graham with my potatoes. Made Graham mush. Picked two qts currants. Mrs G. called & gave me a photo in a frame of Mr & Mrs John Fife - one they gave Mr Green before he died & he told her to give it to some one that knew the Fifes & would like to have the picture - I told her that I was the right one - She also gave me 4 Mayflower bulbs - I wish she would let me do something for her, but she don't altho I offer to do chores for her. Vesta borrowed my A.W. line. Wrote Mrs Samson - Vesta gave me a piece of cake - Read in D. & C. sang &

Thurs 13 Thunder showers last night - and a lively shower of rain with wind - and a little electricity this P.M. Got 1 pt of milk of Miss K. - warmed over victuals. Boiled an egg and made a cottage pudding cake. Stemmed & canned my currants had a pt can & two qt cans, full. used 5 cups sugar heaped a little. Read in Deuteronomy & sang &

Fri 14 Warm - did not build a fire - Called at Simmons. Vesta's & got a pt of milk at Miss K's 2 cts - & the gift of most a qt of butter. Mrs G. got the fully Mayflower for me. Picked a cup of red raspberries - Pulled a few weeds. Read sang &

Sat 15 Very warm. did not build a fire nor have much to eat just crackers, milk, berries, cake, & dried beef - Got a dun from Carrie Tuttle about the bees & hives that I paid Kezia for two or three years ago - don't understand it, & I feel insulted went to Youngs. Bought 10 lbs sugar 60. 2 qt cans 20. molasses 25c. Tablets 10. Ink 5c. Mucilage 10. Crackers 8c - Tacks 5c for Vesta which she will pay to me - Got an armful of bark. Paper from Sadie. Peoples Journal, & 2 Unitas - Read in Piping hot - papers & Deuteronomy - Read awhile this evening &
