Cool & rainy - guess it is the Equinoctial Storm - Steamed 25 little 'tatoes, & a wee pumpkin for summer squash, fried a slice of pork & 3 smallish cucumbers - stewed a little dish full of green tomatoes, with 1/2 a cracker. Read in Mrs G's papers & in Nehemiah. Wrote Eunice Montgomery It seems cold, if it clears off there will be a freeze.

Charlie Phillips & Roy Smith called this evening to see if I wanted to rent my house - I do not - mended the other drawers & the torn trimming on chimise - Finished Nehemiah - Did not try T. Board

Tues 26

Cool & pleasant - no frost. Wanned potatoes & cooked tomatoes. Called & rapped loudly on Miss K's door - no response - Went to P.O. - Got Unity a package of papers from Mina a letter from Sadie & the key to Miss Mildred Millers "act" She wants to sell dew of Roses to me for 50 cts a bottle for me to resell if I can for 75 cts. &c. &c. - I am not the Gull Pulled a few of Sanfords beans when Vesta called to me to come to the house - she wanted things in shop - I gave her 25 cts for the three days lacking to make out her months rent and she gave me 4 potted geraniums & her old sun hat! ha! ha! I didn't say Thanks - or come again - Called on Mrs. G.
