We had a good dinner, with Mr T. & Winnie. and supper. Mr T. Geo. Claude, Frank Bumpus Harry B. Anna Beller sat down with us. Mrs T. let me begin to make a blue calico apron to make for her & I am going to finish it at Fanna's. Mrs T. gave me a large sweet apple and a bouquet of Summer Savory. It sprinkled a little but the shower went to the north of us so we did not get wet. I enjoyed the visit & we came home through Burnham Hollow. Winnie and Gyp did not return with us, & it was dark before we got to Lute's. 29th I finished the apron - read a little & I do not remember what else. ~~the~~ Sat 30. Corwin was salting his animals & came across where I was & I was glad to meet him. Sun Oct 1. I went through the orchard again for pasture. Winnie & Agnes went to Portland with Frank Bumpus.
