Cold but lovely with sunshine - Finished letter to Mrs S. &
sent a dollar bill to A.B. Davis. Collector & Treasurer for Hammon-
ton to pay my tax - bought 6 postage stamps 12cts at P.O. got a
Unity & October's Peoples Journal - a free package of medicine
that purports to be a cure all, and a letter from Nathan asking
about apples, saying beautiful weather & all well at Hammon-
ton Got a basket of bark at mill yard. Mrs Green made me a pleasant
call - returning book & brought dailies - Miss K. called while
I was at P.O. & returned my paper &c. Did not see her
& think maybe she came purposely when I was gone to
give me a hint - Knit & read as yesterday - warmed victuals &
Dr T.D. Phillips buried today - died Sunday of Cancer in Stomach

Wed 18.

Day like yesterday - Fried a slice of pork & made Corn mush
for breakfast. Called on Mrs Simmons - Mrs G. let me have an-
other daily & I am to keep what I have till called for - Wrote to
Sadie Webster &c. & mailed the letter. Got basket of bark
Finished job last night & began Psalms tonight. Called
a few minutes in Nels Store - Knit & read in Sanford's
Cotton & Helios Choice &

Thurs 19. A lovely day. Made griddle cakes for my breakfast
Made some of Fanna's cookies. Ellen & Sanford called
Lute came with a load of wood. 1.50 - Butter & Crock 2.45
& the syrup I had last spring was 90cts - 2 doz eggs 36cts
I endorsed a years interest on the note (4.80). He
worked on the road for Odell place 1.25 & sold
apples of Mine & enough to pay it - so I owe mine 32cts
and Curtis Mansfield paid rent \$12.00 - \$3.00 it for me
Lute left it with me to pay taxes on Odell place - gave
Lute 50 cts & he gave me 10 to balance account & Int.
