Wed 25. Clouds & sunshine - cooler - Made a tomato stew, fried brown bread stewed a dish of apples - Wound 4 skeins of Fanna's yarn - got a gallon oil at Youngs - 7c - and 3 baskets of bark at Millyd. Read in papers - Carried Ellen's Arthur's back to R.C. & got Sanford's Censor - Read two pages in Poems. & knit on sock. Washed an old bed quilt &

Thurs. 26

Cold, breezy & showery - Made a stew with potatoes, onions, butter & dumplings - Mrs G. called to return papers. Chas Phillips to see if I would sell my home & Ella W W to see if I would rent - I said maybe to Charlie - no to Ell. Began reading "A Hardy Horseman" - Read Psalms &

Fri 27.

Rainy - Made griddle cakes - Ironed some. Split kindling Knit - Read as yesterday - &

Sat 28.

Rainy & roof leaking - Cooked 2 beets 1 turnip three or four small carrots - Made & steamed a loaf of brown bread warmed & ate a bowl of stew - made some apple sauce in a dish - Caught another mouse in trap. Was taken sick after I had eaten stew - threw it up with bile - a terrible throbbing where bile originates, not for a long time - Read as yesterday - &

Sun 29.

So sick that I did not know what to do only to keep in bed heard a rapping at the door but did not answer it - It was Vern Derby wanting to put his colt in the barn & he went over to Simmons to see if they knew where I was & Mrs Green came over & built a fire & made spearmint tea & I kept throwing up bile & was so sick she went for Miss K. She came with a bag of boneset - made me tea of that & I drank - vomited drank again & was better - She got my spring couch into the kitchen made it up & I camped for the night & felt so much
