Lisle - I read in papers - Psalms & knit Lute's sock - Wimp Luce called to see if I would let him put the separator to his threshing machine in new barn - I did not know - finally said as far as I was concerned I had no objections - He said he would pay \$2. ♀

Mon 6. Cold & pleasant - Warmred my turnip & brown bread & oat meal, made peppermint tea - ate grapes & apples - and do not feel quite well - Tally is not at all well - Brought in some wood & a couple of baskets of pop corn cobs that Raymond left - the mice had shelled & mussed the corn - Stewed a few apples for sauce. & E. L. Derby gave a silver dollar & two quarters which pays her shop rent until the middle of this month Nov. Read in papers & knit - Mrs Cummings called an hour in evening - I have finished reading Psalms and commenced Solomon's Proverbs - ♀

Tues 7 Pleasant - Made & mush for breakfast - Pared part of a panful of sweet apples for sauce - brought 66 sticks of wood into wood room & some to burn Mrs C. called to get her hand kerchief that she left last night & see if I would go to the village and vote for School Commissioner - I excused myself - Read some in papers & Proverbs & knit finished sock ♀

Wed 8 A nice day - Cooked potatoes & egg gravy - Lute came & brought me a jug of cider, 2 qts buttermilk 1 qt new milk - & yarn from Mrs Tarbox to knit 2 pr socks
